Questions of Character and Integrity

These questions are intended to help you identify areas in which you still need healing and to help us know how to best support you in the process. It is not meant to disqualify you from serving as a leader. We just want to know that you are reasonably free from moral/lifestyle issues that would make it difficult for you to lead effectively. We frequently see potential leaders who are honest about an area of sin or temptation when answering these questions that get help and go on to lead a group with great effectiveness. Let the Holy Spirit do His work in you as you honestly search your heart.

Once you've filled out the Questions of Character and Integrity form, please share it with your Discipleship Community Pastor. He'll connect with you soon to walk through it together.

- 1. Have previous church experiences affected you in either a positive or negative way?
- 2. Describe a time when you had to be corrected by your leader. How did you respond, and what did you learn through that experience?
- 3. How would you describe your current relationship with God? Consider your time in Scripture, worship, prayer, and any recent ways God has been speaking to you.
- 4. Are there any beliefs or values that Christland Church holds that you differ from or don't believe?
- 5. Are you practicing financial stewardship by being generous with time, resources, tithing, etc.?
- 6. In what areas are you currently serving at Christland?
- 7. How comfortable are you with hospitality and having people in your personal space?
- 8. Do you have at least one Christian friend in our church with whom you share your good news, struggles, and problems? If yes, whom?
- 9. Are there any sins or areas of your life for which you have not yet asked for God's forgiveness?
- 10. Do you need to ask for or extend forgiveness to anyone?
- 11. Have you been with anyone of the opposite gender, or same gender, in any context that could be seen as compromising?
- 12. How are you doing with sexual temptation? Are you experiencing freedom in this area, or are you currently struggling?
- 13. Do you feel like Jesus is asking you to serve as a leader? What do you hope to offer others through your leadership?
